Mined Land Wildlife Area (MLWA)

offers two modern rental cabins, Coal Ridge Cabin and Mine 19 Cabin, as alternatives to tent and RV camping. The cabins are located on Unit 30 of the wildlife area overlooking Trout Lake. They are available to rent year-round, and each cabin will accommodate up to six overnight guests. The MLWA offers fishing, hunting, wildlife viewing and primitive camping year-round. The trout lake is a deep-water, clear strip-mine lake, known best for its trout fishery. See fishing regulations for trout stamp requirements.

MAKING A CABIN RESERVATION

To ensure availability, reservations must be made at least seven days prior to the arrival date. Persons 21 years or older may make reservation requests. Reservation can be made by telephone, mail, online or in person up to one year in advance. Online reservations can be made online at reserve.ksoutdoors.com with credit card. Phone reservations also require a credit card payment. Renters must designate which cabin they would like to stay in at the time of making a reservation. There is no vehicle entry fee for this area. Cabin rates are \$70 a night plus a non-refundable reservation fee of \$12 and a 50-cent charge for each transaction. A damage/cleaning fee of \$70 will be collected if the cabin is damaged or left unclean at check-out. Full payment is due at time of reservation.

ABOUT REFUNDS AND CANCELLATIONS

The cabin reservation fee of \$12 cannot be refunded. If your reservation is canceled, however, the reservation fee can be applied to future reservations. If you notify the KDWP District office in Chanute seven days prior to your reservation date of a cancellation, the remaining cabin rental fee may be refunded, or another date may be arranged and your reservation fee applied to the new date.

DATES AVAILABLE

Cabins are reservable year-round. Prices are subject to change. Reservations will be handled on a first-come, first-served basis.

WHAT CABIN RENTAL PROVIDES

Bathroom/shower, AC/heat, microwave, two-burner stove and oven, refrigerator, outside hydrant, charcoal grill, picnic table, dishes, pots and pans, kitchen utensils, coffee maker, and toaster. Sleeping amenities are listed below:

COAL RIDGE (WEST) CABIN

One double pull-out futon, one sofa,
One twin size pull down murphy bed
Two single beds (bunk style)

MINED 19 (EAST) CABIN

One double pull-out futon, one sofa,
One twin size pull down murphy bed
and one double bed

RENTAL DOES NOT PROVIDE

Bedding, linens, bathroom/shower supplies, food/condiments and charcoal briquettes are not provided. Bring your own blankets, sheets, soap, shampoo, pillows, towels and grilling supplies.

CHECK IN AND CHECK OUT TIME

Online cabin renters will be contacted by our cabin rental coordinator through email or by phone and will be given a four-digit access code. Cabin renters who pay rental fees through the regional offices will obtain the four digit code at the time of purchase.

Check in time- 2 p.m.
Check out time- 12 p.m.

CABIN RULES

No pets are allowed in cabins.
Smoking is not allowed in cabins.
No tents or camping units within 100 yards of cabin.
Renters are responsible for damages & missing items.
Upon leaving, clean cabin, dishes, pans and utensils.
All household trash accumulated during stay should be removed and put in dumpster.

From Parsons:

13 miles east on HWY 400
8 miles south on NW 100th ST (gravel road)
1/2 mile west on NW Lawton RD

From Oswego:

4 miles east on HWY 160
3 1/2 miles north on NW 100th ST (paved)
1/2 mile west on NW Lawton RD

From Columbus:

10 miles west of the HWY 7/HWY160 JCT
3 1/2 miles north on NW 100th ST (paved)
1/2 mile west on NW Lawton RD
